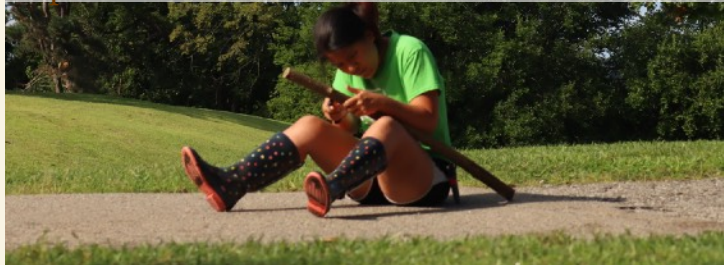
FOREST CRAFT
