Cancellation and Make Up Policies

Hazardous Weather Cancellation

We run programs in a variety of weather conditions - very hot days, very wet days - our educators know how to make the kids comfortable and still have fun!

However there are a few weather conditions that are hazardous for our programs that we will cancel for:

- 1- Thunderstorms or lightning are forecasted at 50% likelihood
- 2- Sustained winds are above 20 mph
- 3- Snowstorms or icy roads
- 4- Temperatures dip below 20F

We check weather every night around 7-9pm, and every morning around 6-7am. We will send an email the night before or an email and text message the morning of to inform you if class is cancelled.

If these conditions arise unexpectedly during the day we will take shelter in the safest place at this location. If needed, we may send text message alerts to all parents to come pick up your child.

The cost of the program includes one weather cancellation. However, if there are subsequent cancellations due to weather after the first one, a credit of 50% of that day will be applied to your account. This means that for every cancellation beyond the initial one, you will receive a 50% credit for that day.
